The Virginia Technology Student Association announces the availability of the **\$500 Monroe Scholarship** for an undergraduate student majoring in teacher preparation - with certification in technology education. The award - in honor of John Monroe, DTE, a Virginia technology educator - is based upon evidence of leadership potential and desire to be a teacher.

Eligibility

Applicant shall be:

1. Resident of Virginia
2. Graduating senior accepted into a baccalaureate degree granting college or university
3. Current member of affiliated Chapter of TSA
4. A student who has demonstrated leadership potential
5. A student who shows evidence of ambition to become a technology education teacher

Application and Deadlines

Applicants must complete in full detail the "Virginia TSA - Monroe Scholarship "Application Form" along with supporting documentation as specified. Application deadline is a postmark of February 1 each year.

The scholarship is administered through the Financial Aid Office of the respective institution. There will be no direct payment to the recipient.

The scholarship is awarded during the annual Virginia TSA Leadership Conference (during the month of April or May). Recipient will be notified at least two weeks prior to the Conference.
